

SOLO/DUO/TRIO CONTRACT

Thank you for your interest in doing a solo, duo or trio with Born to Dance this season! This is always a great opportunity for you to get to work one on one with the teachers, learn more about your individual strengths, and get to perform on stage, showcasing the beautiful gifts that God has placed in you as a dancer, bringing praise to His name through dance!

Please read through the entire contract as you **MUST AGREE WITH ALL TERMS** in order to sign up for solos, duos or trios. Registering and participating in any solo, duo, trio program(s) means both parent and child understand and agree.

- 1) Solos/Duos/Trios need to be registered for by November 1st
- 2) Payment for ALL dances must be made BEFORE your child's first lesson (including payment plans where you have made your first payment).
- 3) Classes will need to be scheduled in advance and, due to the increasing number of programs in our shared space, those times once set will stay. We will always do our best to be flexible, but we need you to respect that you may have to work something around the times we have available as well.
- 4) The fees you pay for solos/duos/trios DO NOT INCLUDE THE FEES YOU WILL PAY TO TAKE THEM TO COMPETITION. Please be prepared to pay an entrance fee for every competition you choose to attend, which is due as soon as prices become available. Once we have signed your child up for the competition(s) of your choice, we cannot take them out and get our money back. Therefore, if you choose to remove your child from a competition, you will still pay for that competition. This is also true if your child does not commit to practicing and therefore does not know their dance, resulting in a teacher having to remove your child from competing.
- 5) Your child MUST be willing to commit to practicing. They will get one completed routine, one cleaning, and one rehearsal. After the cleaning, if your child is still having trouble and needs an extra lesson, please contact our administrator and she will book you a private lesson at \$40/hour. This must be explained to your child before you make this commitment so that THEY know what will be expected of them.
- 6) You are responsible for your child's costume(s). Although teachers may assist, in the end, you must find, choose, and make/purchase your costume (which must also be approved by the teacher).
- 7) Parents/guardians of students or anyone else accompanying them must wait in the waiting room unless permission is specifically given otherwise by the solo/duo instructor
- 8) It is the parent's responsibility to make arrangements to take a video of the routine at the end of each class.

9) Teachers may choose to remove a dance from competition if it is not ready.

10) Students are not allowed to perform their number(s), outside of Born to Dance activities, without express permission from the studio director. There are no exceptions to this rule.

In registering and participating in any solo, duo, trio program(s) you are herein stating that yourself (the parent) and your child (the dancer) fully understand the above statements, are comfortable with the commitment and are therefore ready to take on this awesome opportunity to learn and grow!

In registering and participating in any solo, duo, trio program(s) you are herein accepting the conditions and terms as stated above in regards to your child partaking in competitions for the complete dance year and have fully explained this to your child, and your child is also ready for the commitment of participating in any solo, duo, trio program(s).
